## What the judges thought:

Gentle waterwalls on the pool adhere to the subtle, elegant style preferences of the designer, while providing a highly vertical feature to connect the pool with the motor court above.





serves as something of a skylight for a basement room below. Phillips generally prefers vanishing-edge pools that are free of turbulence. But here, he placed the two waterwalls close enough to the window to create a gentle, rippling effect. This way, anyone sitting in the basement room can look up to see textured, visually interesting water. The frame around the window is white, also against Phillips' modus operandi which tends toward darker colors. But here, too, consideration was given to viewers below by matching the white ceiling rather than the darker finish of the pool.
